

## NYEC F1 Vacancies

### Eligibility Criteria

In order to apply for F1 vacancies commencing in August 2009, within the NYEC FS, prospective applicants must:

- Not already have been allocated to a 2 year Foundation Programme via the Foundation Programme Application System.
- hold or expect to obtain provisional registration with the General Medical Council (GMC) by the start of the Foundation Programme 2009. If you are appointed but have not obtained registration in time, the Trust has the right to withdraw the offer.
- If you have full registration then you may apply but priority will be given to those holding/expecting to obtain provisional registration.
- Already hold PLAB 1 & 2 or have results of both PLAB 1 & 2 by 22 June 2009.
- Be able to prove that your medical degree was studied in English OR have a valid IELTS certificate with a the following (minimum) scores **Overall 7**, Speaking 7, Listening 6, Academic reading 6, Academic writing 6.
- have a valid medical degree recognised by the GMC by the start of the Foundation Programme;
- be in a position to start their Foundation Programme placement in August 2009 (exact date to be agreed with the employer);
- be fit to practise medicine safely in accordance with the GMC's document *Good Medical Practice (2006)*;
- have demonstrable skills in written and spoken English that enable effective communication in clinical practice with patients and colleagues, as set out in paragraph 22 of the GMC's *Good Medical Practice (2006)*;
- supply all relevant documents as requested
