DURATION OF POST

4 months (as part of a 1 year rotational post)

DEPARTMENTAL INFORMATION

The ENT department is situated on the Castle Hill Hospital Site in the old Nuffield Hospital. The Department is the Professorial ENT Department for Yorkshire, with supraspecialist (tertiary referral) exposure to Head and Neck and Thyroid Oncology. Major Ear, Sinus and Rhinoplasty Surgery is also performed.

DUTIES OF THE POST

The F1 Doctor will be expected to take part in the first on call rota for acute ENT, although major acute head and neck pathology will initially have been triaged on the Hull Royal site. The job will involve the daily care of post surgical patients and participation in ENT clinics, morning ward rounds and operating lists.

WORKING ARRANGEMENTS/JOB PLAN

The F1 Doctor work a full shift rota, but will not be on the hospital at night rota, managing the ENT patients instead in the ENT and Breast Unit. Outpatient and Theatre exposure will be divided up between the FT and CT staff dependent upon career aspirations and requirements as much as possible.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The F1 will be expected to become proficient at managing routine ENT emergencies and general ENT outpatient presentations. Achieving competency at aural microsuction and flexible laryngopharyngoscopy is the norm. Weekly teaching sessions on a Monday lunchtime occur in which the junior staff present on a regular basis. Involvement in research and audit is expected.
