LOCATION

Princess Royal Hospital, Hull. Beds and inpatients at Castle Hill Hospital and Hull Royal Infirmary.

DURATION OF POST

4 months (as part of a 1 year rotational post)

DEPARTMENTAL INFORMATION

This is a very busy outpatient dermatology unit with approximately 22000 outpatient attendances/year. In addition there are outreach clinics at different sites which the F1 is not expected to attend. There are 5 inpatient beds available to the department but due to site constraints these are at HRI and CHH. We have surgical, phototherapy and patch testing facilities. There are dedicated paediatric and minor surgical clinics and "one stop" clinics. There are currently 2 consultants, 1 associate specialist 3 staff grade doctors, a GP registrar and an FI post attached to the department.

DUTIES OF THE POST

This involves being present in the department and seeing patients under supervision in clinics. The post holder is expected to clerk in patients and review all the inpatients when they are present. When not in clinics the post holder is expected to review day cases and see patients with the nurse specialists. There may be an opportunity to learn and perform minor surgery on skin lesions.
