General Information

Scarborough is a sea-side resort on the east coast of Yorkshire. Although naturally isolated due to its geographical position, it is set in beautiful countryside near to the North Yorkshire Moors and the Yorkshire Wolds. The area covered by Scarborough District includes fishing ports and sea-side resorts of Whitby, Filey and Bridlington and includes the market towns of Malton, Pickering, Helmsley and Kirkbymoorside, as well as numerous villages in the area. The local industries are agriculture, tourism and fishing. There are some medium-sized industrial concerns in the towns in the area, especially Scarborough. Scarborough is linked to York and Thirsk and thereby to the A1 and M1 by good roads. There is a rail service from Scarborough to York, Leeds and Hull. Entertainment and sporting facilities in and around Scarborough are excellent. There are good yachting facilities at Scarborough and good golf courses.

The Department

The department of gastroenterology is integrated with general medicine and surgery.

The gastroenterology staff at consultant level are Dr CJ Mitchell and Dr P S Babu as Physicians and Professor J MacFie, Mr K Mainprize and Mr C Mahon as Surgeons.

There is a full endoscopy service including ERCP and close links with GI surgery including weekly joint round and MDT.

There is an active Gastroenterology Research Group with an excellent publication record.

Conditions of service

A full shift is worked with out-of-hours being fully integrated with general medicine which is fully compliant with both New Deal and WTD targets with annual leave incorporated into the rota.

The tenure of this post is 4 months.
