General Information

Scarborough is a sea-side resort on the east coast of Yorkshire. Although naturally isolated due to its geographical position, it is set in beautiful countryside near to the North Yorkshire Moors and the Yorkshire Wolds. The area covered by Scarborough District includes fishing ports and sea-side resorts of Whitby, Filey and Bridlington and includes the market towns of Malton, Pickering, Helmsley and Kirkbymoorside, as well as numerous villages in the area. The local industries are agriculture, tourism and fishing. There are some medium-sized industrial concerns in the towns in the area, especially Scarborough. Scarborough is linked to York and Thirsk and thereby to the A1 and M1 by good roads. There is a rail service from Scarborough to York, Leeds and Hull. Entertainment and sporting facilities in and around Scarborough are excellent. There are good yachting facilities at Scarborough and good golf courses.

The Department

There is one Paediatric ward at Scarborough Hospital. There is also a purpose-built extension to the Paediatric ward which forms the Paediatric Outpatient Department and deals with the assessment of handicapped children.

The work involves sharing in and supervision of the management of most children admitted to Scarborough Hospital and direct responsibility for the day-to-day running of the neonatal services.

Duties

Contact to be maintained with the nurse in charge of the ward and instruction and advice on treatment to be issued.

Responsibility for the day-to-day care of all medical admissions to the children's ward at Scarborough Hospital, the admission of all acute surgical paediatric cases and for the admission of a small number of children receiving dental surgery.

Responsible for the routine examination of normal new born babies in the maternity ward, resuscitation of the new born in the delivery suites and the care of patients in the Special Care Baby Unit.

Child assessment sessions and multi-disciplinary case discussions are held at Scarborough Hospital and the peripheral clinics.

Conditions of service

A full shift is worked which is fully compliant with both New Deal and WTD targets.

The tenure of this post is 4 months.

The salary scale and conditions of service are those of Hospital Medical & Dental Staff.

Single accommodation is available if required. Family accommodation is subject to availability.
